What should I avoid donating?

Please avoid donating:

• Expired food items

• Opened or partially used products.

• Used/open toiletries

Can I donate fresh produce?

Yes.

When and where can I drop off my donation?

Donations can be dropped off at 1 East Road, Cambridge, CB1 1BD. Please park down Bradmore Street near the eye clinic and ring 01223 576085, someone can come round and collect. If it is after 6pm, donations can be taken to our main front door on East Road.

Can you accept clothing donations?

We have limited space for storing items at Jimmy's and, where we can, have to prioritise food. Therefore we only buy clothes when needed. Often this is done as part of the support and encouragement towards independence which includes help with applying for a grant and then a shopping trip (which may include a trip to a charity shop if the resident wishes) to buy items the residents chooses to wear.

Do you collect?

Yes, so if you are able to drop collections off at our East Road site this would be hugely appreciated. We do understand this is not always possible though. If you do need a collection.
